Subject Number One: **Brief Synopsis of the Car Committee**

Discussion:

- Event Related Activities
  - Parking cars for daily show-n-shines at various venues
  - Provide moderate level of security throughout the day for cars parked for the daily show-n-shines
  - Traffic and crowd control for nightly cruises in Sparks, Reno and Grand Sierra Resort
  - Stage cars for the Grand Finale Parade held on the final Sunday of the Event
  - Provide crowd control for Sunday's Grand Finale Parade
- Handle parking and security for our annual Spring Fever and Fall Frenzy car shows
- Assist with parking for various summer Wednesday night cruises when requested by sponsoring properties
- We handle car related special events throughout the year i.e. the Sparks Hometowne Christmas Parade and other events as they arise.
- All monthly committee meeting minutes will be posted on line

Subject Number Two: **Spring Fever**

This is our season classic car kick-off show-n-shine. Held on Saturday, May 15<sup>th</sup> in the west parking lot of the Atlantis Casino Resort from 10AM to 2PM.

Discussion:

- Venue set up begins at 8:30AM
- Cars will start showing up prior to this time so we will need people to assist with parking as early as 8AM
- Event is open to all 1972 and older American and European classics only
- Pop ups have been a problem in the past, how should we handle this?
  - Add a blurb to the days agenda about this being a wind prone area and that pop ups are discouraged
  - Hand out the same flier that deals with pop ups and umbrellas that is given out at the Event in August. This should be given at the check-in booth when they receive their lunch tickets and dash plaques

### Subject Number Three: **South Lake Tahoe Show**

#### Discussion:

- We will be responsible for parking cars and moderate lot security for the 5 designated show-n-shine lots
- These 5 venues are open to our registered participants only
- All registered participants will have a window sticker similar to the Reno/ Sparks event
- There will be nightly cruising however, the cruises will be open and participants will have to obey normal traffic laws, lights, signs, etc. Therefore the cruises will not be manpower intensive. We will only need to have a presence on the street.
